Player of the Year – Jennifer Bengel, Gettysburg, Sr., Forward

Notes

- Bengel is the first Gettysburg player to earn Player of the Year honors. She becomes the first Bullet and sixth player in Conference history to earn first-team All-Centennial honors three times.
- Piscadlo and Courtney are the first Muhlenberg teammates named to the first team in the same season.
- Kimball's first-team nod makes it 12 of 13 years that Johns Hopkins has had a player named to the first unit (2001).
- This is the tallest first team in Centennial history, averaging 5-10 1/2. The 2003 team held the record at 5-9 3/4.
- Johns Hopkins leads all Conference teams with 16 All-Centennial first-team nods since 1994. Franklin & Marshall is second with nine, followed by McDaniel (8), Swarthmore (8), Dickinson (7), Gettysburg (6), Muhlenberg (6), Ursinus (4) and Haverford (1).
- Four students were also named to the Conference Academic Honor Roll, which recognizes sophomores, junior and seniors who are key performers and have a 3.40 cumulative grade point average or higher.
